Greater Baltimore History Alliance Reciprocal Admission Program Guidelines

- This program is an added benefit for individual members of participating Greater Baltimore History Alliance (GBHA) sites. Museum members who join at a level equivalent to \$100 or above can enjoy free general admission when visiting other participating GBHA sites. **Valid for free general museum admission for 2 people.**
- No other benefits or discounts provided by the original membership except **free general admission** are extended from the partner museum. The free general admission does not apply to "materials fees," or additional cost for special programs.
- In order to receive the free admission benefit at a partner museum the **visitor must show the GBHA Reciprocal Membership Card and the original museum membership card.** Visitors should also be prepared to show a picture ID.
- The GBHA Reciprocal Membership Card expires one year from issue date.
