## Do

5. When you color the tree, think of what you can do to help our earth. (HINT.....reuse items, such as plastic bags, place trash in trash cans, not on the ground.)

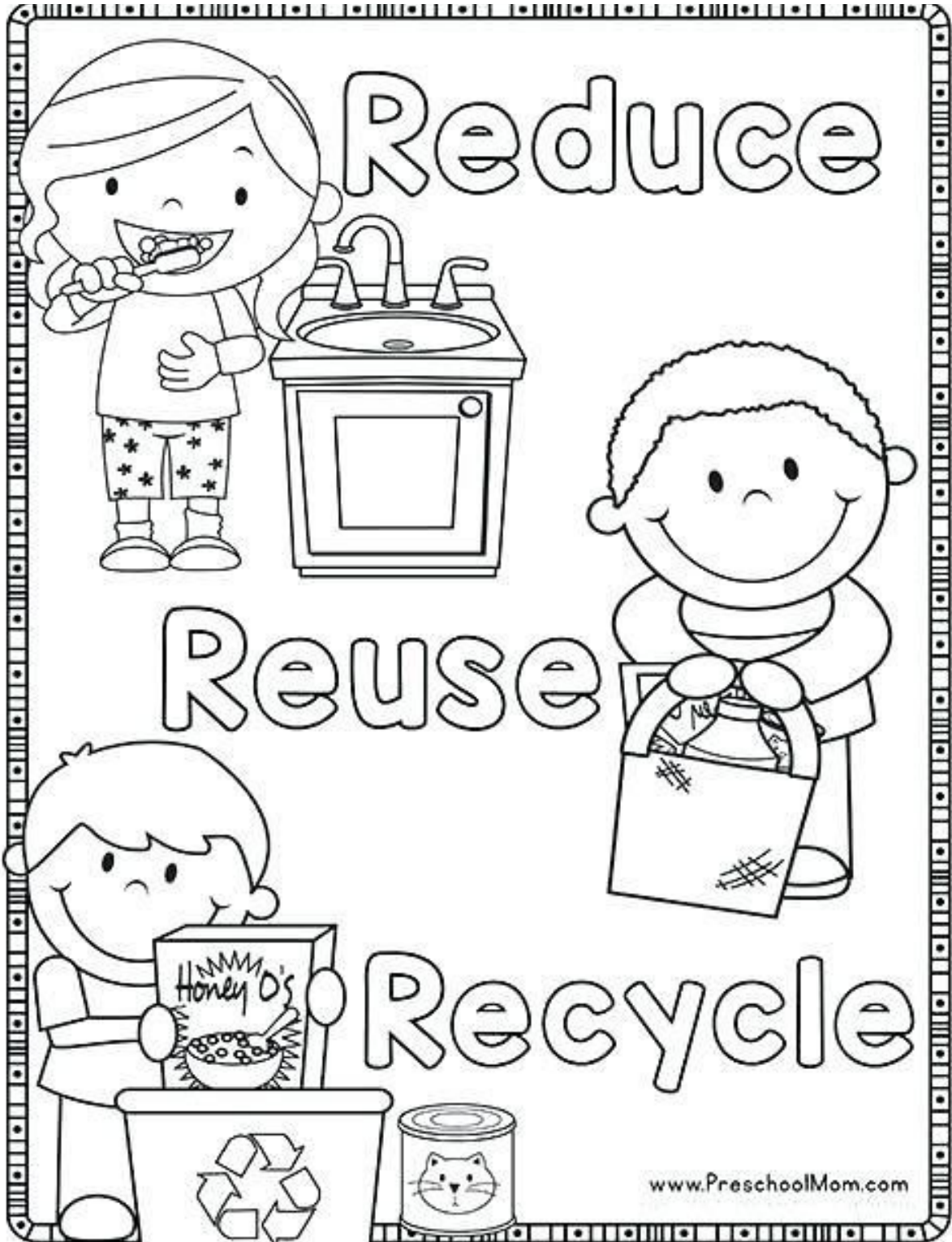
