## **Classroom Resources: Post-Visit**

- 1. Write a letter to your museum educator at the BMI reflecting on your experience of the guided tour and what you learned using the prompts below as inspiration:
  - a. 100 years ago, there were hundreds of factories in Baltimore, but today there are only a few. Why do you think most of the factories have closed?
  - b. What types of machines do you think are used in today's factories? How are they different from the machines you saw on your tour?
  - c. Of the jobs you learned about on tour, which would you like to have, and which would you not like doing? Which jobs would workers have wanted 100 years ago? Which would they have disliked?
