Thank you for volunteering to chaperone your student's upcoming field trip to the Baltimore Museum of Industry. To ensure a safe, educational, and fun experience for everyone, please review these guidelines for teachers and chaperones:



- A museum educator will lead your group throughout the day, including through transitions between activities.
- **Remain with your students at all times** and keep your students with the rest of the group.
- **Know how many students are in your group** for quick counts. Make sure you know their names and they know yours!
- **Let the students do the work**, but provide encouragement and support if necessary.
- **Be present.** Your full attention is needed to ensure students are safe and engaged. Please minimize phone use and stay focused on the students.
